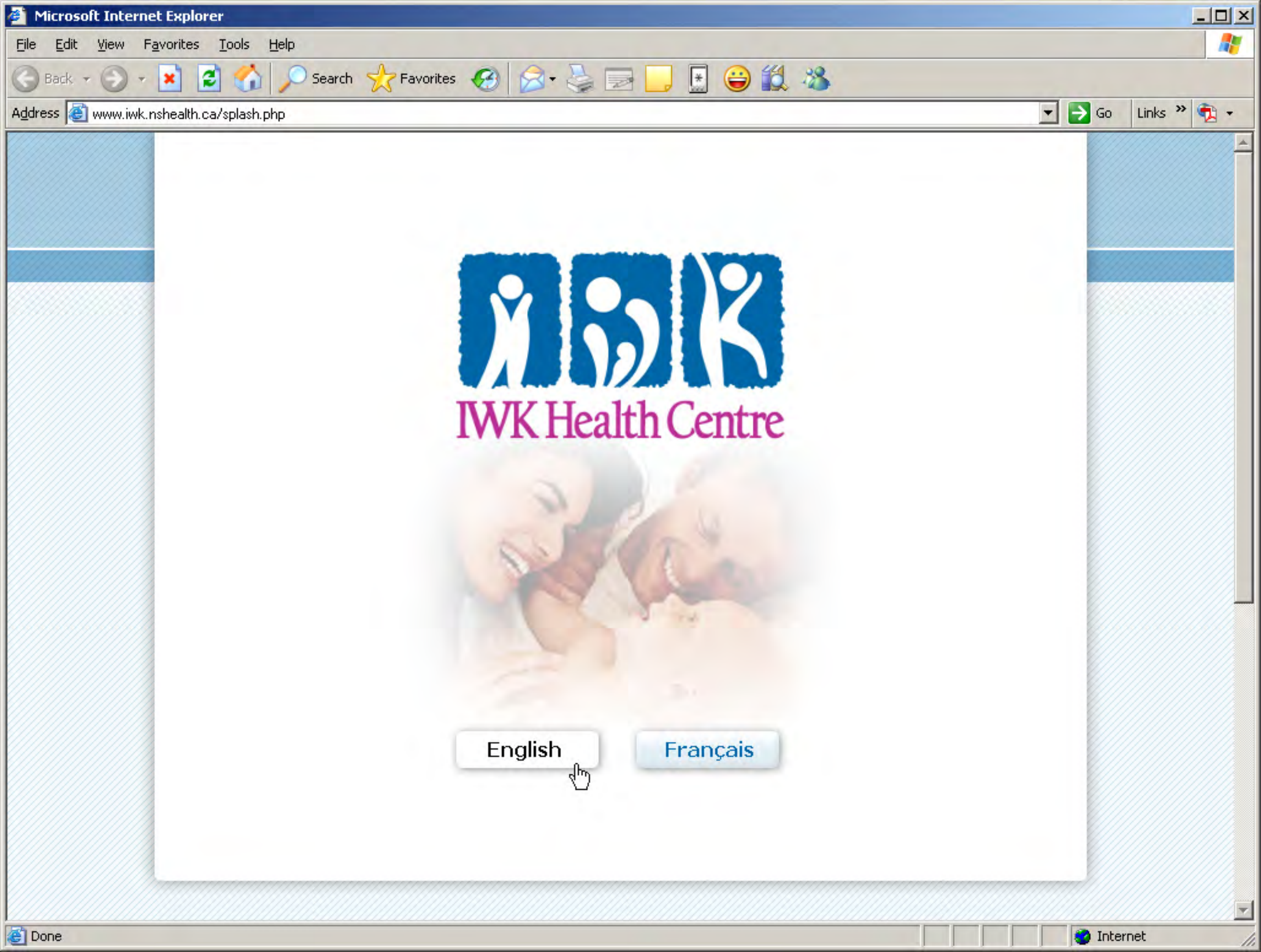

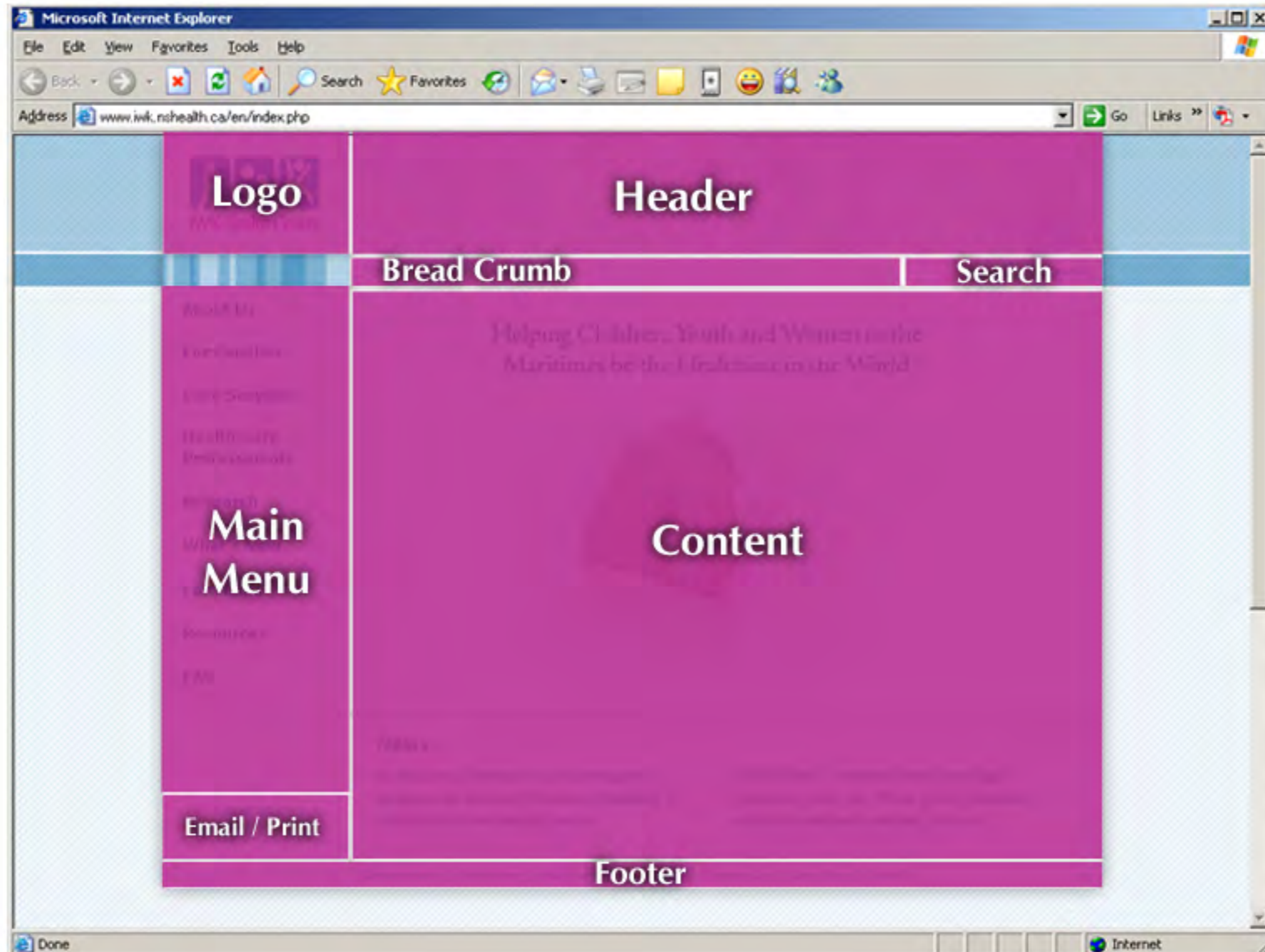

Children over six months of age may have their usual food until midnight before surgery and clear fluids up to three hours before the scheduled surgery time. A clear fluid is something you can see through - it has no floating particles in it for example; water, sugar water, apple juice, popsicles, freezies, etc. - do not give breast milk, cow's milk, formulas, jello, orange juice, or other liquid containing particles as they are NOT clear fluids.

Children under six months of age may have their usual feedings up to four hours before the scheduled surgery

Aspirin or aspirin products should not be given up to one week before surgery, but acetaminophen (for example Tylenol®, Panadol®) may be given.
